

# PERMISSIVE ACCESS

This access has been provided by the Higher Level Stewardship scheme, which helps farmers protect and improve the countryside, its wildlife and archaeology. The footpaths at Penpont Farm form a farm trail which provides two circular walks which link with the public footpath in Chapel Amble. A bird hide provides views over Amble Marshes and opportunity to watch wetland birds. Keep dogs on a lead to protect ground-nesting birds and grazing livestock. The farmer manages grassland for breeding and wintering wading birds and to protect nationally important archaeology, including an Iron Age settlement and a rare prehistoric monument known as a cursus, and overwintered stubbles for declining farmland birds. The farmer also provides educational access running farms tours and visits.
