BY ROAD - From Exeter, take the A30 via Okehampton and Launceston. Just after Launceston, fork left then take A395 towards Camelford; when it joins A39, fork left and follow the A39 through Camelford towards Wadebridge.

About a mile after passing the St Kew Highway Filling Station, look for a sign pointing to the right for Chapel Amble. Take this right turn. Nearly there! (Ridgeway Park is immediately on your left hand side). At the next T-junction turn right. (Penpont Mill is the house situated on the opposite side of the road). Travel one mile further along this road and The Olde House is on your left just before the small bridge at the edge of the village.

From Wadebridge on A39 towards Camelford, turn left at the first Chapel Amble signpost. (½ mile further along this road on the left hand side is Penpont Mill). Drive one mile further along this road and The Olde House is on your left just before the small bridge at the edge of the village.

Look out for the brown tourist signs on all approaches to The Olde House.

BY AIR – We are just a 20 minute drive from Newquay Airport. If you are coming to Cornwall by air you'll find plenty of taxis at the airport to bring you to The Olde House.

BY TRAIN – Come out of Bodmin Parkway and turn left onto the A38, travel through Bodmin and follow the A389 towards Wadebridge. At the large roundabout at Wadebridge, take the third exit towards Camelford. You can now follow the direction above From Wadebridge.

- **Greenbank** is situated in the village on the right hand side of The Malsters Arms Public House.
- **The Retreat** is the third house on your left when entering the village.
- **Smeathers** is a little further on. Go past the village P.O. and The Pottery.
Take the St Minver road for approx. 1 ½ miles. On a sharp left hand bend you will see a Public Footpath sign on your right hand side together with a slate sign for Smeathers.
The farmhouse is at the end of the driveway.

Call at the Reception in the main farmhouse and we will help you find your cottage.
Drop your bags and put your feet up, there'll be a Cornish cream tea waiting for you.

Please note that your cottage will not be ready for you until 4.30pm on the day of your arrival and you need to leave your cottage by 10.00am on the day of your departure.

If you anticipate arriving after 6.00pm, then please tell us by telephone 01208 813219, so arrangements can be made for you at reception.
